as we approach the bicentennial of the lewis and clark expedition in 2004 attention will inevitably turn to the nineteenth century explorers who risked life and limb to interpret the natural history of the american west beginning with meriwether lewis and his discovery of the bitterroot the goal of most explorers was not merely to find an adequate route to the pacific but also to comment on the state of the region s ecology and its suitability for agriculture and of course to collect plant specimens in this book williams follows the trail of over a dozen explorers who botanized the rocky mountains and who by the end of the nineteenth century became increasingly convinced that the flora of the american west was distinctive the sheer wonder of discover which is not lost on williams or his subjects was best captured by botanist edwin james in 1820 as he emerged above timberline in colorado to come upon a region of astonishing beauty

the essays cover an astonishing range of subject matter from mental health and plastic surgery to literature music political

philosophy performance popular culture and history they interrogate the dominance of whiteness exposing the underpinnings of white privilege and considering its global consequences

can an injured wolf and a broken witch heal each other alice sheffield tore her soul into pieces and hid them to escape a soul eating demon free at last she longs to rebuild herself as something new and stronger but she doesn't know how then a catalyst for change enters her life ewan shaw was shot with an ensorcelled silver bullet that has tainted his blood and bound his wolf beyond his reach he retreats to his friend's rural farm to lick his wounds and contemplate his lack of prospects renowned for his cold detachment he is fascinated by broken alice and the heat she stirs within him then fate presents an opportunity in bringing an old foe to justice ewan might find a path for his life and a way for alice to confront her demons but to do that two broken people must heal each other or shattered pieces will be lost forever

this book before the pioneers indians settlers slaves and the founding of miami by andrew k frank explores the extensive history of the north bank of the miami river which has been a significant site of human occupation for around 4 000 years the book delves into the diverse groups that have inhabited the area including the tequesta indians spanish colonists african slaves and others it examines the environmental and social factors that influenced the development of the region and how these early inhabitants laid the groundwork for the establishment of miami the narrative spans from geological formations to the complex interactions of different cultures reflecting on the area's role in broader historical themes such as colonialism slavery and urban development this scholarly work is intended for an audience interested in florida's history and the foundational elements that shaped miami long before its official founding

in classical terms the georgic celebrates the working landscape cultivated to become fruitful and prosperous in contrast to the idealized or fanciful landscapes of the pastoral arguing that economic considerations must become central to any understanding of the human community's engagement with the natural environment timothy sweet identifies a distinct literary mode he calls the american georgic offering a fresh approach to ecocritical and environmentally oriented literary studies sweet traces the history of the american georgic from its origins in late sixteenth century english literature promoting the colonization of the americas through the mid nineteenth century ending with george perkins marsh's *man and nature* 1864 the foundational text in the conservationist movement

rayside conducted informal interviews with more than 150 glengarrians and attended numerous meetings of local councils school boards planning boards and conservation authorities this field research provides the basis for a detailed examination of the self image of the town as a friendly caring united community and of the unequal power relations that exist between different social classes language groups and men and women working class life is disadvantaged in alexandria much as it is in large cities french english relations are strained and the experience of women has not been affected to any great extent by the challenges of feminism local government in alexandria may be more accessible to the ordinary citizen than it is elsewhere but as rayside shows the local council rarely engages in issues of genuine concern to residents who themselves largely ignore municipal politics most local politicians seem inclined to avoid controversy and innovation hoping to retain an environment favourable to business investment rayside examines the impact of the external world on a small community he situates this impact and the resulting changes in historical context and reveals economic and social relationships that differ from what many of alexandria's inhabitants believe to be the case a small town in modern times will be of interest not only to students and scholars of political science sociology history and canadian studies but also to residents of alexandria and any other small community in transition
